**9th grade vocational class:** The 9th grade vocational class focuses on careers and training while providing general education. The 9th graders are guided through vocational training and actively prepare their future vocational studies or apprenticeship.

**CAP/2-year intermediate vocational certificate:** This 2-year certificate follows the 9th grade class. It trains skilled workers in specific trades. CAP graduates can join the work world or can pursue their education in vocational studies.

**CAP/1-year Early Childhood:** For this training, applicants must have graduated from CAP, vocational Bac, vocational training. be 18 years old. The applicants must send a resume and a covering letter and be fully vaccinated.

**BAC PRO:** This 3-year vocational degree starts after 9th grade. It focuses on careers and training while providing general education. Bac Pro graduates can step into the work world or continue their studies in **BTS**, a 2-year vocational and technical college degree or follow another further education program.

**Mention Complémentaire:** This 1-year further education certificate starts after a Bac (vocational, technical or general). It focuses on **Hospitality in Travel** and responds to a need for on-the-job training and certification in customers and users reception and service in travel., with a major in communication, English and transport regulations.

**Internships:** Internships are compulsory in 9th grade, CAP, Bac and MC. Vocational high school students gain hands-on skills and insight into a career field, they apply what they learn in class and develop their professional attitude. These training periods are assessed and taken into account in their grade average and final exams. These work experiences are also a useful addition to their resume. Combined with school education, internships help students to grow up as students, persons and future professionals.

#### CAP Retail Sales Associate (Equipier Polyvalent de Commerce - EPC)

Retail sales associates perform many roles including stocking shelves, assisting store customers and cashiering. They work in a variety of environments like department, groce-

ry, hardware and electronics stores. They assist in changing the price of products and switching out promotions. Some work primarily in the return and exchange department. A CAP graduate can continue in Vocational Bac with a major in Sales.

 BAC PRO Sales and Customer Service (Métiers du <u>Commerce et de la Vente option A)</u>: A sales clerk provides good customer service, handles customer gues-

tions and complaints, uses pricing guns, cash register and point-of-sale software, displays items in the store, bags purchases efficiently and prepares sales contracts.





A sales clerk works in a variety of stores, including supermarkets, department stores and apparel outlets.

### **BAC PRO Outside Sales Repre-**

#### sentative (Métiers du Commerce et de la Vente option B): An

outside sales rep meets and sells customer in the field. The representative should have strong sales and interpersonal skills that are crucial in establishing relationships with customers and closing sales. These customer service skills are necessary to communicate over

the phone, on line, or in face-to-face meetings with potential clients to highlight the most appealing products or services to sell. The rep



#### BAC PRO Tourism and Hospitality

(*Métiers de <u>l'Accueil et du Tourisme</u>*) : In the service of customers, travelers, vacationers, this hospitality professional can be a front desk staffer in a tourist information office, a reception officer in an amusement park, a ticket office manager in a museum, an activities coordinator in a leisure center, an information desk clerk in a rail-

way station. Hospitality management with a focus on tourism requires good people skills, strong communication abilities in native and foreign languages (major in English), problem-solving, planning and software communication skills, cultural awareness.



#### **CAP Electrician**

The CAP Electrician graduate learns electrical theory and basic equipment in installation and wiring in housing (individual and collective) under the supervision of a senior electrical

technician. Course topics include regulations, safety of people and property rules, energy efficiency in building, environmental protection and sustainable development.

#### BAC PRO Electrical Engineering and Connected Environment (Métiers de l'Électricité et de ses Environnements Connectés-MELEC)

The Bac Pro MELEC graduate installs, maintains and repairs electrical systems and equip-



ments in commercial or residential settings while ensuring installation safety, regulatory compliance and quality. Course topics include cost reducing, energy efficiency in building, environmental protection, sustainable development and connecting equipments and systems in collective and individual housing.

#### BAC PRO CNC Machining Operations and Programming (Technicien en Réalisation de Produits Mécaniques-TRPM): CNC refers

to **Computer Numerical Control** and describes programmable machines that are used for mechanical processes such as milling or drilling. CNC machine programming is a specific set of coding rules that make up CNC software required to run lathes, mills, routers, grinders, laser cutters, and other ma-



chines. A **CNC** Programmer is responsible for the programming, design, and development of this software as well as setting them up to run on CNC machines. Quality requirement and environmental concern are included in course topics. CNC machine operators may work in aero-

nautics, food industry, vehicule industry, tool technology, precision engineering.

Certificate in Hospitality in Travel (Mention Complémentaire Accueil dans les Transports): The graduate is in charge of traveler and user reception, guiding, service and support in railway and

bus stations, ferry and airport terminals, airport terminals, car renting agencies and lobbies. Operations include problem solving, checking-in and out and boarding, while implementing safety procedures and regulations.



### CAP Early Childhood (Accompagnant Éducatif Petite En-



*fance):* The CAP is the first qualification level in early childhood (less than 6 years old) careers. Graduates may work as a childminder, caring for babies, toddlers and young kids in their own home, supporting their learning

and development and caring for their needs. Another career option may be nursery or daycare worker .

## BAC PRO Community and Home Care Support

(Accompagnement Soins et Services à la Personne): This highly-skilled degree leads to a large variety of careers depending on the work



environment: home, day care centers, communities, old people's homes or companies. A home care and support worker supports people with all aspects of their day to day living, including social and phy-

sical activities, personal care, mobility and meal times. Specific skills

are needed in this role: good listening and communication skills, the ability to understand and follow policies and procedures, flexibility, caring and compassion.



# BAC PRO Signs Design and Making (Craft) (Métiers d'Art option Métiers de l'Enseigne et de la Signalétique):



Sign makers are involved in all aspects of sign fabrication, from design to installation. They work for businesses, government agencies, nonprofit organizations and academic entities. Successful sign makers have skills in graphic design, silk screening and painting. They review a client's sign request,

makes design recommendations using software and sign-making equipments to create backgrounds, lettering and artwork within the borders of the design. Manufacturing signs uses a variety of materials: wood, vinyl, plastic, aluminium...
